The West Village Community Drop-In offers essential respite care for families who need it most. We provide a rich, play-based learning environment where toddlers can thrive.

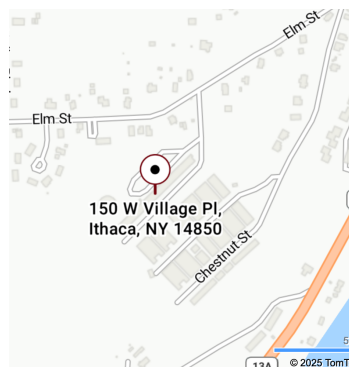

## What Do We Do?

The West Village Community Drop-In provides a safe, fun, nurturing, and educational setting for toddlers.

## How Does It Work?

**Children:** The program is designed for children ages 18 months to 5 years.

**Parents/Caregivers:** Parents or caregivers need to register with the program by filling out a contact card.

**Volunteer Requirement:** The program relies on parents or caregivers to volunteer however they can, once a month.

**Capacity:** The West Village Community Drop-In has a maximum capacity of 10 children per day.

**Schedule:** The Drop In is open on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9-12. We are open year-round.

## Our Mission

The Ithaca Care Collective is dedicated to building strong connections among parents of children who are not enrolled in formal childcare. Our goal is to create inclusive and welcoming spaces where families can share experiences, support one another, and navigate the challenges and joys of early parenthood together.

At the heart of our work is the spirit of *ubuntu* — the understanding that our humanity is bound together through care, compassion, and community. Ubuntu reminds us that every child's growth is nurtured not only by their family but by all who surround them.

## What Will I See at the West Village Community Drop-In?

You will see play! Play is a child's work. Through play, children learn problem solving skills, develop language, practice fine and gross motor skills, and learn important social skills. Here is how our days flow:

### Daily Schedule

9:00- 10:30 -Breakfast, Free Play, and Table Activity (small group instruction through crafts games/investigations/cooking)

10:30-11:30am -Clean-Up and Outdoor Play

11:30-12:00- Wash Hands, Lunch and Read Aloud

Parents/caregivers are welcome to stay, or may leave the premises. We enjoy having you around, but understand if you could use a break.
